## MEDICATION RESTRICTIONS FOR ALLERGY SKIN AND PENICILLIN TESTING

Certain medications can interfere with allergy skin and Penicillin testing. Therefore, you may need to **temporarily** stop taking certain medications prior to being skin tested. Please refer to the list below and restriction time.
